YMCA Preschool Full Day Program: ages 33 months to Kindergarten

Hours: 6:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Days: Monday – Friday

Begins: September 8, 2008 year round program

Vacation Days: One week vacation.

The YMCA recognizes that children learn in different ways. The full day format strengthens learning by utilizing the Creative Curriculum and enrichment activities. The structure provides an excellent alternative to conventional day care. A nutritious breakfast, lunch and snack are included. Full day children need to be working towards potty training.



YMCA Preschool Part Day Program

Hours: 9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

For ages 4 to 5 years old**

Days: Monday/Wednesday/Friday

Begins: Sept. 9, 2008; Ends June 4, 2010

For ages 3 years old*

Days: Tuesday/Thursday

Begins: Sept. 8, 2008; Ends June 4, 2010

This is an option for families who do not need full day care but want their child to have a preschool classroom experience. This half day program utilizes the Creative Curriculum to achieve the same results as the full day program and also provides enrichment experiences.



ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES INCLUDED IN BOTH PROGRAMS:

Kidz Fit: builds a foundation of healthy habits while having fun. Your child will enjoy learning about the importance of taking care of their bodies, exercise and movement.

Music and Movement: explores musical concepts in a variety of ways including singing, dancing, rhythm activities, finger play and musical instruments. These activities help to bridge the connection between music and movement, and develop large and small motor skills, focused listening and self-expression.

Reading Buddies: 8th grade reading buddies are great role models that help stimulate interest in literacy.

Other activities include cooking, nutrition, arts & crafts, library, multicultural studies and nature.

How to Register:

1. Fill out the enrollment form. Ages must be as of September 1st, 2009.
2. A registration fee of \$50.00 **per child** must accompany the registration form before any child can be considered enrolled or be placed on the wait list. *Registration fee is non-refundable.* Return the form to:

3. The first months tuition is due on August 1. If it is not received your spot will be forfeited to those on the wait list. During the school year, tuition must be paid by Monday, one week prior to the start of each month or week.
4. Confirmation will be mailed out upon completed registration. Full packet will be mailed by August 1, 2009.
5. **Childcare immunization records and health care summary are due on Monday, one week prior to the start of the program. The child will not be allowed to attend unless we have these health forms. This is a state law. The state requires and checks that a physician has signed the health form.**
